A Word In Season

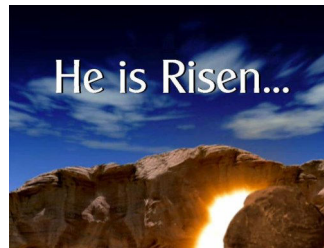
“But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, [5] Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) [6] And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus.” (Ephesians 2:4-6)

Living Saviour, Living Hope!

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.” (1 Peter 1:3)

One major thing that distinguishes Christianity from all other faiths and religions in this world, is the fact that it is founded on a Leader who is alive! (see also Revelation 1:18). The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the basis of the Chris-

tian Faith (see 1 Corinthians 15:1-22). Verse 14 says: *“And if Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain.”* It is the resurrection of Jesus Christ that has brought us HOPE to live by, both in

this life and in the one to come! (see 1 Peter 1:3; 1 Corinthians 15:19). This is the reason why, as Christians, no matter how hopeless things may be in the world, there is always a supernatural Hope for

us in Jesus Christ! We just need to release our Faith accordingly! In Romans 4:18 the Bible says that Abraham “against hope believed in hope” in order to experience fulfillment of God’s promise to him. In other words, when his circumstance looked naturally hopeless, he believed in supernatural hope by exercising his faith in God. We must learn to always do similarly because God never fails to keep His promises. Just as He kept His promise to resurrect Jesus Christ (see Acts 2:22-32) even so shall He keep every promise in the Bible that concerns us as Believers in Jesus Christ. So, no matter the circumstance, declare right now: **THERE IS HOPE FOR ME IN JESUS CHRIST!**

Resurrection Power - Exceedingly Great Power!

“And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, [20] Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, [21] Far above all principality, and power, and might,

and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:” (Ephesians 1:19-21)

According to the above Scripture, the Power of Christ’s Resurrection is exceedingly great in its

working. It raised up Christ FAR ABOVE everything else! This month let us prayerfully release our faith in that same Resurrection Power to put us FAR ABOVE all things that are contrary to God’s Will for us in all aspects of our lives!

Words of God produce the fruits of good (see Matthew 19:17 and 1John 1:5) and these we see manifest as blessings (Deuteronomy 28:1-14), fruit of the spirit showing in our lives (Galatians 5:22-23), good deeds, success in every area of our lives, healing and health, and eternal life. (See Psalms 1:1-3 and Joshua 1:8)

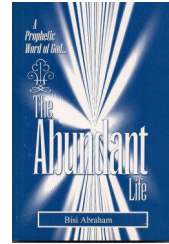
Everything we hear or see has a potential to affect what we say or confess out of our mouths and thereby affect the fruit we bear in our lives.

Jesus revealed to us in John chapter 15 these things:

- 1) A believer must bear fruits (verses 1&2)
- 2) A believer must bear good fruits (verse 8)
- 3) Good fruits come from the word of God (verse 3)
- 4) Without the word of God we can't bear good fruit (verses 3-7)
- 5) We were called into God's kingdom to bear good fruits (verse 16)
- 6) Only the good fruits last (verse 16)

- 7) Good fruit is associated with answered prayers (verses 7 & 16)

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
