A Word In Season

"Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: [14] That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith." (Galatians 3:13-14)

It's All About Jesus Christ And His Redemption Work!

"And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. [2] For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him crucified." (1 Corinthians 2:1-2)

As the great Apostle Paul said by the Holy Spirit in 1 Corinthians 2:2 quoted above, his determination was to focus on Jesus Christ and His crucifixion, and not on any other thing. In other words, his focus was solely on:

1. The PERSON of Jesus Christ, and

2. The REDEMPTIVE WORK that Jesus did for us on the Cross of Calvary.

These two things are foundational things of our Christian faith (see also 1 Corinthians 1:17-18; Colossians 2:13-15; Galatians 3:13-14; Galatians 6:14). Therefore, they

ought to be the focus of our thoughts and the core of our declaration to others, in order to help them come to know the Salvation that Jesus brought for mankind.

Therefore, the "Easter Season" is not about arguments or debates as to what the Season should be called - "Easter" or "Passover" or "Resurrection"? (see Colossians 2:16-17). Rather, the Season is all about Jesus Christ and His Redemptive Work, and seizing the opportunity to help others come to the knowledge of the Salvation that Jesus Christ purchased for us by His sacrifice on the Cross of Calvary!

Like Apostle Paul, let us be determined to solely consider Jesus Christ and His crucifixion! <u>JE-SUS CHRIST</u> is the only Reason for the Season!

You Have Been Empowered By The Holy Spirit To Walk In Newness Of Life!

"Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life." (Romans 6:4) Resurrection Life is a New Life - the God kind of Life, and it is what God designed for us to walk in as Christians. This New Life is the Overcoming Life that Jesus came to give us to enable us walk in victory over all the works of the

Devil (John 10:10). As the Bible says, Jesus Christ was manifested to destroy the works of the Devil (1 John 3:8). Therefore, choose to walk in Newness of Life by choosing to walk in FAITH and OBEDI-ENCE to God's Word!

Divine Power Is In The Arm

We are going to look at the topic: "Divine Power Is In The Arm." And we know in Isaiah 53:1, it says there, "Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed?" And so we see that Divine Power is in the Arm: Divine Grace; Divine Might; Divine Strength; Godly Power, for all power belongs to God, is in the Arm of the Lord. And so we have to understand exactly what the scripture is saying about our Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, who is the Arm of the Lord, so that we are able to come to Him and ask Him for

help in every situation of life. We are not talking of human power. The scripture is quite clear that the arm of flesh will fail; the power of flesh will fail

nothing but the Di-

vine Power of God.

and will forever fail. The flesh profits nothing, but the Divine Power of God, Jesus Christ, will never fail.

Please let's open to 1 Corinthians. Let's start off from there. We are going to be looking at many scriptures today, so that we may understand the Person of the Arm of the Lord. Let's

first look at 1 Corinthians 1:24. In fact, let's take it from verses 23-24: "But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumbling block, and unto the Greeks

foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God." And so we see it clearly,

Christ is the Power of God and the Wisdom of God.

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and
 personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who
 worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
