A Word In Season

“God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.” (1 Corinthians 1:9)

Keep Your Faith Steadfast By Remembering God’s Faithfulness To Perform His Promises!

“Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;).” (Hebrews 10:23)

In our walk of faith we sometimes stumble, thereby allowing our faith to waver, because we make the mistake of focusing on the circumstance and relying on our human effort or individual ability to exercise faith in the word of God. The scriptural truth is that every time we focus on the circumstance or rely on our human effort, we are not in the genuine kind of faith that pleases God. This is because the right kind of

faith that pleases God always focuses absolutely on the Word of God and the Faithfulness of God to unfailingly perform every promise that He has made in His Word! (see Romans 4:19-22). Genuine Faith never stands in the wis-

dom of man; rather it always stands in the Power of God! (see 1 Corinthians 2:5).

In Hebrews 10:23 quoted above, the Bible clearly states the reason why we are encouraged to *hold*

fast the confession of our faith without wavering. That reason is: *“for He (God) is faithful that promised.”* In other words, God is FAITHFUL regarding His PROMISES! This truth is also emphasized in 1 Thessalonians 5:24 - *“Faithful is He that calleth you, who also will do it.”* God can be absolutely relied upon where His promises are concerned because *“He abides faithful: He cannot deny Himself.”* (see 2 Timothy 2:13). Remembering the Faithfulness of God to perform His Promises is of great necessity for anyone who wants to walk by steadfast faith which the Holy Bible says that Christians need in order to successfully RESIST the Devil (1 Peter 5:8-9).

Do Not Forget That You Need Patience In Order to Receive The Fulfillment Of God’s Promises!

“Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. [36] For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.” (Hebrews

10:35-36)

If we want to successfully keep our faith steadfast unto the victorious end and experience the fulfillment of God’s promises, we need to understand the important role

that patience (endurance or perseverance) plays in the process of receiving the fulfillment of the promises contained in the Word of God. This is also emphasised in Hebrews 6:12 - *“... faith and patience inherit the promises.”*

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

So Ezekiel gave them the word and their confession of the dry status was changed by the word of God.

If you are still confessing negative things and being emotional about situations in your life, you need to feed your spirit with the word of God, which qualifies your new status in Christ Jesus and allows faith in the word of God to grow in you.

As the word grows in you, **faith grows along too, at the same time.** You can't have faith in God without the word of God - **"So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed."** (Acts 19:20, KJV). Romans chapter 10 verse 17 also says: **"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the**

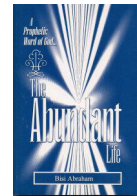
word of God." KJV

Most believers expect to have faith without starting and continuing to explore all the avenues of hearing the word, for example: personal meditation, preaching of the word, bible study, discipleship classes, etc. All church events are not instituted just to fill the programme and time. Praise and worship aspect of the church service, for instance, is necessary to draw the breath of God (the Holy Spirit) to breathe on your situation and every area of your life.

Through all these avenues you are hooked up permanently to the ZOE Life of God and people see you as a blessed man or woman of God (Psalm 1:1-3). God in His love for us warned us about forsaking the assembling together of the saints (Hebrew 10:25),

because He knew that we will not have His ZOE Life as He wants us to have it, if we don't have fellowship with other believers (Psalm 133:1-3; Acts 2:42-47 and Acts 4:23-35).

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
