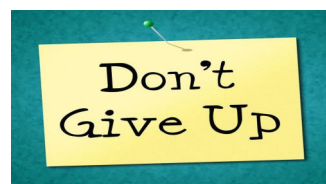
Don't Stop Believing, Don't Stop Hoping; Just Be Patient!

“And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: [12] That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.” (Hebrews 6:11-12)

Every promise in the Word of God is SURE (Psalm 19:7; Isaiah 55:10-11) and will be fulfilled by God in DUE SEASON (Luke 1:20; Habakkuk 2:2-3).

Therefore, you can al-

ways rest assured that whatever your circumstance, the relevant promise in the Holy Bible will ultimately prevail. All you need to do is: keep believing, keep hoping and keep standing patiently on the relevant promise until it manifests physically in its God-appointed DUE SEASON.



“And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.” (Hebrews 12:2)

Scripturally, patience means forbearance or fortitude. It is the quality that bears up under all kinds of pressure without

quitting or giving up. It is what helps faith to win in every situation.

Now, patience is the fruit of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22). Therefore, every Christian has the potential for it. It just needs to be ACTIVATED by constantly meditating in the Word of God (Romans 15:4; Joshua 1:8) and praying in the Holy Spirit with other tongues (1 Corinthians 14:4; Jude 20). According to the Bible, it is the Holy Spirit who STRENGTHENS US UNTO ALL PATIENCE (Colossians 1:11). And He always does His work in us while we are WAITING UPON THE LORD by meditating in His Word and praying (Isaiah 40:31; Psalm 27:14; Psalm 130:5).

After Waiting Patiently, The Word Of God Will Surely Come To Pass In Your Life!

“And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.” (Hebrews 6:15)

The Bible records several examples of how God rewarded those who pa-

tiently waited with fulfillment of His promises to them. In Hebrews 6:15 we see clearly that Abraham received the promised Isaac AFTER he had patiently waited. Another example is found in James 5:11 where the PATIENCE of

Job is praised as the key to his experiencing double-fold restoration of all the blessings that he had lost. (see Job 42:10). The Bible says that we need patience AFTER doing the will of God before we can receive His promises (Hebrews 10:36).

Contend And Never Let Go Of Your Blessings

Please let's read Deuteronomy 2:24-25 - *"Rise ye up, take your journey, and pass over the river Arnon: behold, I have given into thine hand Sihon the Amorite, king of Heshbon, and his land: begin to possess it, and contend with him in battle. This day will I begin to put thee upon the nations that are under the whole heaven, who shall hear report of thee, and shall tremble, and be in anguish because of thee."* Please underline **BEGIN TO POSSESS IT AND CONTEND WITH HIM IN BATTLE**. We thank God that He has given us the Word of Covenant, from Genesis to Revelation, and we are in God's Kingdom. We are in this

world but not of this world. We have to understand that we belong to the Kingdom of God. And we all know that John chapter 10 says that we will be going into the sheepfold; we will go in and find pasture - find food or find things to help us. Inside of Christ is everything we need to live in this world successfully. In Him we live and move and have our being. Inside of Christ is the Word of God. So we will find the Word of God to live successfully on the face of the earth. *We will live days of heaven on earth.* But there is something we have to do -

"But we know that it is a battle that is already won in Christ Jesus."

BEGIN TO POSSESS IT AND CONTEND WITH HIM IN BATTLE! Begin to possess your promise, begin to possess your blessings, your breakthroughs, your divine interventions. Begin to possess every spiritual blessing in Christ Jesus. And then contend with *him*. Who is the *him* there? The **ENEMY!** Contend with the enemy of our soul; contend with the devil. But we know that it is a battle that is already won in Christ Jesus.

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
