#### A Word In Season

"Therefore also now, saith the Lord, turn ye even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning: [13] And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the Lord your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil." (Joel 2:12-13)

# Understanding The Scriptural Purpose Of Fasting

"Wherefore have we fasted, say they, and thou seest not? wherefore have we afflicted our soul, and thou takest no knowledge? Behold, in the day of your fast ye find pleasure, and exact all your labours. [4] Behold, ye fast for strife and debate, and to smite with the fist of wickedness: ye shall not fast as ye do this day, to make your voice to be heard on high. [5] Is it such a fast that I have chosen? a day for a man to afflict his soul? is it to bow down his head as a bulrush, and to spread sackcloth and ashes under him? wilt thou call this a fast, and an acceptable day to the Lord? [6] Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? [7] Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and

that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?" (Isaiah 58:3-7)

True fasting is a means of humbling our souls in order to bring it in subjection to our spirit. This, in

turn, helps us to learn to "walk in the spirit and not fulfil the lust of the flesh" (Galatians 5:16). A close look at Isaiah 58:3-7 quoted above clearly

shows that the kind of fasting that is acceptable to God involves refraining from doing our own pleasures so that we may do God's own! It also shows that fasting involves doing those things which clearly reveal that we genuinely love God wholeheartedly and that we also love our neighbours as ourselves! Fasting is therefore more than a mere religious exercise. Rather, it is part of our holy devotion to God and is meant to CHANGE US instead of God! This is why the Bible, talking about fasting in Joel 2:13, encourages us to REND OUR HEARTS, and not our garments, and TURN UNTO THE LORD OUR GOD! Let us heed these instructions whenever we fast and pray!

## The Mighty Power Of Combining Prayer And Fasting Together!

"And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting." (Mark 9:29)

In the above scripture, Jesus teaches us that a combination of prayer and fasting is absolutely required to overcome certain circumstances. In other words, victory in such circumstances can only be obtained through prayer and fasting; not by any other means! This clearly shows that the prayer-and-fasting-combination is a power-

ful weapon that is available to us as Christians. When we pray while fasting, our prayers are more empowered because fasting helps to take our flesh out of the way so that our spirit may make maximum contact with God!

# THE WORD: FOUNDATION OF EVERYTHING

#### ...Continued from last month

We must take note of what Genesis 2:4-7 says. Let's take a closer look at verse 5 "... and no shrub of the field had yet appeared on the earth and no plant of the field had yet sprung up for the Lord God had not sent rain on the earth, and there was no man to work the ground, but streams came up from the earth and watered the whole surface of the ground."

The seed needs rain or water to germinate and these come from the Lord. The streams that came up from the earth could only keep the earth moist and not grow anything until the Lord gave the command.

The Lord God is the one who increases the seed (2 Corinthians 9:10) through His presence, which guarantees the abundance of His River of the Water of Life (Genesis 2:8-10); Revelation 22:1,2).

Earlier we examined Isaiah 55:10-11 which says, "As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

From the above, we can infer a truth that the word of God is likened to a seed. A deeper look at these verses will reveal some significant truths: the rain works on the seed, that is, the Lord is present where His word is. The word of God is also the rain and water, because the word of God has the breath of God coating it. The word of God will grow and grow very well on the 'earth', that is, the

word has the ability to increase and increase very well to the size desired by God - because the word has life. (John 6:66-68). God is Spirit. (John 4:24) Therefore His Word is Spirit. (Revelations 1:9-18 and 19:11-13).

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
