A Word In Season

"Sanctify ye a fast, call a solemn assembly, gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of the Lord your God, and cry unto the Lord." (Joel 1:14)

Have Confidence In God And His Promises As You Fast & Pray!

"And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: [15] And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him." (1 John 5:14-15)

Having confidence in GOD and His WORD whenever we pray is an expression of our genuine faith and trust in God's faithfulness to always keep His promises. The Word of God (Holy Bible) is a compilation of His Will as revealed to mankind, through the ages, for every generation to live by. The Bible in Hebrews 6:17-18 describes GOD and His PROMISE as two IMMUTABLE things in which God cannot lie and by which we might have a strong consolation (i.e. comfort, en-

couragement or confidence)! Therefore, as we seek the Lord corporately with fasting and praying this month, let each one of us remember that our con-

fidence is in God and His promises rather than our human abilities to fast and pray! In line with this, it is necessary to remember, at this time of fasting and praying, the instructions that God has given us in the Holy Bible about how to fast in a way that pleases Him (i.e. according to God's Will). Therefore, in addition to the main theme scriptures that we are using in our prayers this month (Psalm 138:8; Hebrews 13:20-21) everyone of us should diligently meditate on the following scriptures that apply to fasting in order to ensure that we are all seeking God, in our fasting and praying, AC-CORDING TO HIS WILL: Isaiah 58:1-14: Joel 2:12-13: Matthew 6:16-18

God Hears And Answers Prayers In Awesome Ways!

"O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come. By terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; ..." (Psalm 65:2,5)

The above scripture reveals that God not only

hears prayers, He also answers them in *terrible* (i.e. *awesome*) ways according to His Righteous will for us! Similarly, Jeremiah 33:3 says when we call (pray) to God, He will answer and show us GREAT and MIGHTY things! Furthermore,

Ephesians 3:20 describes God as The One who is able to do EXCEEDING ABUNDANTLY above all our asking and thinking! Therefore, as we fast and pray this month, let us not limit God. Rather, let us expect awesome answers from Him!

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

... continued from last month

Verse 25 - 28 says: But while everyone was sleeping, his enemy came and sowed weeds among the wheat, and went away.

When the wheat sprouted and formed ears, then the weeds also appeared.

The owner's servants came to him and said, 'Sir, didn't you sow good seed in your field? Where then did the weeds come from?' "An enemy did this," he replied. The servants asked him, 'Do you want us to go and pull them up?'

The enemy sowed evil seeds **while everyone was asleep** - this is a state of rest, inactivity. Application of this scripture to a believer means that if

you don't continue in the word you are asleep and giving room to the enemy to sow evil seed. Evil seeds are sown with the aim that the plant that comes out of them - if allowed to germinate - will compete with, or even take totally, the nourishment meant for the good seed and tree. In other words they dry up the spirit, flesh and bones - spiritual dryness sets in.

Verse 29-30 says: "No, 'he answered,' because while you are pulling the weeds, you may root up the wheat with them.'

Let both grow together until the harvest. At that time I will tell the harvesters: First collect the weeds and tie them in bundles to be burned; then gather the wheat and bring it into my barn."

Jesus is saying here that you and I have the ability to grow and produce good fruit even when surrounded by evil seeds and plants - Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and staff, they comfort me. (Psalm 23:4) Also see John 17:11,12. All we have to do is continue to sow the word of the Kingdom in faith, with the power of the Holy Spirit.

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
