A Word In Season

"Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: [8] For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened." (Matthew 7:7-8).

Scriptural Requirements For Answered Prayers

"He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him." (Psalm 91:15)

God is a prayer-hearing and answering God! He never fails to hear and answer the prayers of the righteous (Psalm 34:15,17). Often times, the reason why we don't receive answers to some prayers is because they are not deemed righteous in God's sight! In such cases, our prayers are "strange" in the sight of God just like Nadab and Abihu who offered strange incense to God! (Leviticus 10:1-3). It is therefore imperative for us to clearly understand,

from God's Word, the things which our Righteous God demands from us when we pray! If we offer these things to Him whenever we pray, our prayers will be righteous in His sight and will also avail much! (James 5:16). The following are basic scriptural requirements for guaranteed-answered-



"And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;" (Luke 18:1)

prayer:

- 1. It must be asked according to the Will of God (1 John 5:14-15)
- 2. It must be asked in

faith without any doubting (James 1:5-8)

- 3. It must be asked in the Name of Jesus (John 14:13-14; John 16:23-24)
- 4. It must be asked with an unselfish motive (James 4:3)
- 5. It must be asked with a persevering attitude (Luke 18:1-8; Luke 11:5-8)
- 6. It must be asked with the help of the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:26-27)
- It must be asked with thanksgiving (Philippians 4:6; Colossians 4:2)

Whenever you pray, ensure that the above requirements are in place!

Genuine Prayer Is More Than A Religious Exercise; It Is A Heart-felt Communion With God!

"And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. [6] But thou, when thou prayest,

enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly." (Matthew 6:5-6)

Genuine prayer is a heart-to-heart commun-

ion with God rather than an outward show of piety! <u>It involves sincerity</u> <u>of heart in desiring God's</u> <u>Will to be done in our</u> <u>time of need</u>! If our hearts are not in tune with God, when we pray, our prayers are in vain! (see Matthew 15:7-9).

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

Remember that at this time prophet Ezekiel was in exile with the rest of Israel in Babylon (Ezekiel 1:1-3). The Promised Land was desolate because of the sins of the children of Israel. They turned to idolatry and the wrath of God was aroused against His people.(2 Chronicles 36:1 -20); 1 Kings 9:1-9) The divine covering over the land of Israel was removed and the enemy had access to them.

Because of the Lord's friendship and covenant with Abraham and Israel's repentance, God started the process of restoration. (1 Kings 8:46-53; Ezekiel 36:37-38)

Verse 3 says: "He asked me, "Son

of man, can these bones live?" I said "O Sovereign Lord, you alone know."

Ezekiel acknowledged that God is the God of the spirit man, and that He (God) is sovereign over everything, including life and death. (Read 1 Samuel 2:6 and John 5:21)

Verses 4-6 say: "Then He said to me "prophesy to these bones and say to them, Dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! This is what the Sovereign Lord says to these bones: I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life. I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. Then you will know that I

am the Lord,"

The Lord not only gave Ezekiel the word, He also moved him to speak the word. (Jeremiah 1:9-10; 2 peter 1:20-21) Ezekiel sowed the word of God.

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
