"Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God." (Colossians 4:12)

Watch And Pray Perseveringly For All Christians!

"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;" (Ephesians 6:18)

According to the Bible in Ephesians 6:10-20, the main reason why we are admonished to put on the "whole Armour of God" is that we may be equipped to resist the Devil, by watching and praying perseveringly for all saints and for the preaching of the Gospel. In verse 17 we are taught to take "the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God" as an 'offensive' part of the Armour of God in conjunction with the 'defensive' parts listed in verses 14-17, and pray for all saints and for the preaching of the Gospel (see verses 18-20). This is the true heart of Christianity - extending the Love

of God to others by praying for them always. The Bible further teaches that all Christians are one family of God here on earth (Ephesians 3:14-15).

We 'suffer' together and we 'rejoice' together as one family (1 Corinthians 12:12,26). This is why praying for one another is of vital importance in ensuring that we all walk in the victory which Jesus wrought for us on the Cross of Calvary over two thousand years ago. In fact, if we would simply obey God and pray for those that wrong us rather than murmuring or complaining about them (see Romans 12:10-21), we will become the one happy family of God to show the whole world that God truly makes the difference in the lives of His people! It's time for us to do as Epaphras did in his own days and always pray perseveringly for one another! (see Colossians

Remember What Jesus Does Always And Choose To Do Likewise!

"Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them." (Hebrews 7:25)

The above scripture clearly reveals what Je-

sus ever lives to do make intercession for His people! Jesus' intercession for Peter against the Devil's plan (see Luke 22:31-32) further emphasises the ceaseless prayer ministry of Jesus for His people. Now, as followers of Jesus, each Christian ought to be praying ceaselessly for others in agreement with Jesus. It is the Devil we all ought to be resisting, not one another! Let us obey Jesus' instruction to *"go and do likewise"* (Luke 10:37) and imitate Him in our prayer lives!

God Has Chosen His Word To Bless You

Please let us open our Bibles to 1 Corinthians 1:27-29 and let's read it together: "But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should glory in his presence." We see a pattern here -God choosing the weak things; the things we look down on; the things we think are inconsequential, to confound the things that are mighty. We see that the way God chooses is different from the way we choose. The ways of God are higher than our ways and the thoughts of God are

higher than our thoughts. So, why is God making us understand, with the mind of Christ, that the things which are despised by us are the things He has chosen? The answer is quite clear. One thing we have to

would pick up to read and understand. We think that other things are far more important than the Word of God. But we have to understand that the Word of God is Jesus Christ, the Son of God, written down for us. And God has chosen Him who is despised to be our Blessing! We

have to understand that it was through the Word of God, Jesus Christ, that all the things we see round about us were made. Hebrews 11:1-2 clearly teaches us that all things were created by the Word of

> God. And so Jesus Christ made all things. Also, every Blessing is in Him. Now, what are we to understand? Every resource, everything we need, everything that

pertains to life and godliness is in Him, Jesus Christ the Word of God.

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
