“And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.” (Luke 1:45)

Thank God for the great times of refreshing that we had from His presence as we sought Him with fasting and praying last December whilst responding in faith to His promise to us that: *“2020 - God Shall Perfect It For You.”* Now, as we begin the new year 2020, we must remember that faith is a continual life-style of the Believer (Hebrews 10:38). Therefore, our believing should not end with the

December Prayer & Fasting but must continue throughout 2020 and beyond! We need to steadfastly keep our eyes and our hearts on what God has promised to do for us in 2020 regardless of how things look to us based on our natural senses.

DON'T STOP believing

“And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.”
(Matthew 21:22)

Remember that as Christians *we walk by faith, not by sight* (2 Corinthians 5:7) and *trust in God with all our heart without leaning on our own under-*

standing (Proverbs 3:5). Furthermore, the Bible encourages us to not cast away our confident faith in God but to be patient to receive the reward of the ultimate fulfillment of His promises in our lives (Hebrews 10:35-36). Therefore, every day, challenge yourself to keep believing and expecting God to perform His promise that: *“2020 - God Will Perfect It For You.”* As it is written: *“For the needy shall not always be forgotten: the expectation of the poor shall not perish for ever.”* (Psalm 9:18). Also: *“And they that know thy name will put their trust in thee: for thou, Lord, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.”* (Psalm 9:10). Have a glorious testimonies-filled 2020 in Jesus name! AMEN!!!

All Things Are Possible To Those Who Choose To Believe!

“Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”
(Mark 9:23)

As Jesus said in the scripture quoted above, if anyone would choose to believe, *all things* are

possible to that person! Obviously *all things* that Jesus refers to are those in line with the Will of God. Now, the Word of God (the Holy Bible) is the revelation of His Will. Therefore, if anyone would choose to believe God on the basis of

His revealed Word, every situation that the Word is applicable to become possible to that person! In other words, God will back that person who believes His Word with His Divine Power to perform what looks naturally impossible!

Establishing The Word of God Through Prayer

Please let's open to Numbers 20, we are going to combine it with Matthew 18:15-20 but let's first look at Numbers 20. I would encourage everyone of us to read from verse 7-13.

Let's zero down to verse 8: *"Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink."* Please underline the sentence: *"and speak ye to the rock before their eyes."* And so we see they had a problem - no water, dryness round about them - and they complained and the Lord told Moses what to do - gather everybody together and *speak ye to the rock* before their eyes. Now, let's look at verses 9 and 10: *"And Moses took the*

rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him. And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock?" Now, those are words of unbelief - *"must we fetch you water out of this rock?"*. Verse 11 says: *"And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also."* Verse 12 says: *"And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.*" Now, you can see

that he did not believe that by merely speaking to the rock water would gush out. So, he did as before when the Lord told him in Exodus to *strike the rock*. And we know that Jesus only died once and is risen, so He cannot be killed over and over again. What should we now do as sons of God in Christ Jesus. That is what we are seeing here - *speak to the Rock*. Speak to the Rock (Jesus Christ) and all our needs will be met. That is the whole essence of gathering together to pray. It is an opportunity to take scriptures and speak them to Him as the Rock.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
