A Word In Season

"For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith."
(Mark 11:23)

Beware Of What You Are Saying!

"A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. [21] Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof." (Proverbs 18:20-21)

More often than not, our life's circumstances are direct products of what we have been saying or confessing with our mouths. Many of us do not pay due attention to what we are saying because we are ignorant of the power of confession. Proverbs 18:21 quoted above, says that our belly (literally life) shall be satisfied (filled) with the fruit of our mouth! In

other words, what comes out of our mouths, either spoken carelessly or deliberately, will bear corresponding visible fruit in our lives! Furthermore, the Bible says: "The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out



"For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned." (Matthew 12:37)

foolishness." (Proverbs 15:2). This means that we can train ourselves to speak right words at all times by ensuring that what we say lines up per-

fectly with the Word of God. In fact, saying things contrary to God's word will surely be detrimental to our lives. This is because the Word of God is LIFE (John 6:63; 1 John 1:1) and anything opposed to life can only produce DEATH! In James 3:2 the Bible says: "For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body." In other words, the ability to exercise self-control and ensure that we don't stumble in what we say will help to keep us in a state of perfect wholeness! Therefore, let us beware of what we say and always choose to use our tongues wisely to sow towards a good harvest of LIFE!

Consider God First, Then Speak Words & Think Thoughts That Are Acceptable In His Sight!

"Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Lord, my strength, and my redeemer." (Psalm 19:14)

The key to ensuring that we don't say things that

may adversely affect our lives and which we may also regret later, is to consider God first before we speak. This is what the fear of God, which the Bible describes as the beginning of wisdom, is all about. If we only consider ourselves or our

circumstances, we are likely to say the wrong words because we shall then speak according to our will rather than God's will. Like David, let us pray daily: "Set a watch, O Lord, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips." (Psalm 141:3)

THE WORD: FOUNDATION OF EVERYTHING

Verse 12 says, so that, "they may be ever seeing but never perceiving, and ever hearing but never understanding; otherwise they might turn and be forgiven!"

Of course this is referring to unbelievers who do not understand the word and can not perceive the deep things of God, as revealed in His word, because of the veil that is still over their hearts.

Verse 13 says, Then Jesus said to them, "Don't you understand this parable? How then will you understand any parable?"

The implication is that we must

understand the parable of the sower to really understand how the kingdom of God works. It also points out the fact that this particular parable is the foundation to understanding the other parables of Jesus in the Bible. As believers, the veil has been removed from our hearts, so we have the grace to understand this parable, which is the key to understanding how the word of God works in our lives.

Let's take a closer look at verse 14, which says ... The farmer sows the word.

The word "sow" means to scatter, spread abroad or deposit. So the farmer scatters or spreads abroad the word. It means the farmer

must treat the word like seed. Apparently, the farmer the Lord Jesus is talking about is a *spiritual farmer*.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
