Make Jesus Christ Your First Consideration In All Things!

“Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. [3] For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.”
(Hebrews 12:2-3)

When taken in context from Hebrews 12:1, God encourages us in the Scripture (Hebrews 12:2-3) quoted above to look unto Jesus and CON-

SIDER Him both as our FOCUS and EXAMPLE in running the race of faith that we have been called to run as Christians. Furthermore, 1 John 2:6 says: *“He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked.”* In other words, if we claim to be Christians, we have to walk as Jesus

did! To do this successfully, in every situation our first thought and consideration should be: WHAT WOULD JESUS DO IN

THIS SITUATION? The answer to this all-important question can always be found in the Bible (The Word of God) because Jesus Christ is THE WORD OF GOD (see John 1:1-15; Revelation 19:13; Luke 24:27; John 5:39) Therefore, as Jesus Himself said in John 5:39, SEARCH THE SCRIPTURES to find out how He would do in any situation of life and DO LIKEWISE! If we consider ourselves or anyone or anything else instead of Jesus (the Word of God) FIRST, we are going to end up disobeying God! Our own ways may look right to us (Proverbs 21:2) but if they are not the same as God's Ways they will lead us to destruction at the end! (Proverbs 16:25)

Make A Personal Choice To Acknowledge God In All Your Ways!

“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. [6] In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.” (Proverbs 3:5-6)

Never think that you are

wise enough, apart from God, to know WHAT or HOW to do in any circumstance of life! The Bible says that human or worldly wisdom is foolishness (see 1 Corinthians 3:18-20) and comes to nothing (see 1 Corinthians 1:19; 2:6).

The only wisdom that works perfectly is the WISDOM OF GOD which can always be found in the Bible (The Word of God). Hence, we need to individually ACKNOWLEDGE God in all our ways by choosing to OBEY His Word!

Christians Live For The Will Of God

Please let's open to Matthew 8:18-27. We are looking at how the Lord Jesus demonstrated His Power - Power to still the storms of life; for the Apostles in the boat were in the storms of life. The enemy who pours forth proud waters like a storm, the troubles of life, was against them. And it's the same thing we go through in this life. *Many are the afflictions of the righteous but the Lord God delivers him from them all.* And so we see the enemy's storm against the disciples and our Lord Jesus demonstrated His Power to handle the enemy. Remember the Scripture says: *for this reason was the Son of God made manifest to destroy all the works of the Devil.* No matter

what he does, Jesus has the Power to destroy all his works and to bring to nought all the troubles of life. The Scripture already says this of Him. But let's look at something; a great key in Matthew 8:18 - *"Now when Jesus saw great multitudes about him, he gave commandment to depart unto the other side."* What are we seeing there? It was our Lord Jesus who said to His disciples to go to the other side. And verse 23 says: *"And when he was entered into a ship, his disciples followed him."* He was there in the ship with them. In other words,

they were in the will of God. And I tell you, one thing we have to understand is that in the will of God the enemy will throw storms at us. The troubles of life will come even when we are in the will of God. But guess one thing: if it is according to the will of God we know that Jesus is in the ship there with us. We know that He will come in unto the scene of our lives to put a stop to the storms of life.

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
