## A Word In Season

*“For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.” (James 3:2)*

## Beware Of Offences When They Come To You!

*“Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe unto him, through whom they come!” (Luke 17:1)*

*“Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.” (Psalm 119:165)*

The two scriptures quoted above clearly teach us two key things about offences:

1. They are inevitable in this world. (Luke 17:1)
2. We can be equipped to not fall for them when they come. (Psalm 119:165)

An offence can be defined as something that causes us to stumble in our walk of faith and righteousness. Its goal is always to get us out of God’s Will and rob us of God’s Blessings! (see Mark 6:1-6). Jesus revealed that the ultimate

source of offence is Satan (see Matthew 16:23) even though the offence may be manifested through people or circumstances. This is why Jesus said we should forgive people who offend us (Luke 17:3-4; Matthew 18:21-22). The

truth is that such people are ‘tools’ the Devil uses due to their ignorance of Godly Truth (Luke 23:34; Acts 3:17; 1 Timothy 1:13). However, nowhere in the Bible did God say we should forgive the Devil - he is the real offender!

Offences can come to us in virtually all areas of life - at home, at work, at church, in the family, amongst friends, etc. but in all cases, wherever the offence, God expects us to deal with it in a Godly way rather than our own human/fleshly way. For example, Jesus gave us detailed instructions on how to handle offences amongst Christians in Matthew 18:15-17. This is to help us to not fall for offences when they come!

## Be Careful Not To Do Something That Offends Your Fellow Brethren!

*“Wherefore, if meat make my brother to offend, I will eat no flesh while the world standeth, lest I make my brother to offend.” (1 Corinthians 8:13)*

God not only expects us

to not fall for offences but also to not offend others. We must be careful not to offend our fellow brethren in the course of indulging ourselves in our own ‘likes’ or ‘rights’. What is permissible to us may not be the right thing to do if

it would constitute an offence to our fellow brethren. This is why the Bible says that we should not allow our good to be evil spoken of (Romans 14:16) for the sake of the other person’s conscience (1 Corinthians 10:28-29).

# THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

Verse 13 and 14 says, *Then you, my people, will know that I am the Lord, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. I will put my spirit in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land. Then you will know that I the Lord have spoken, and I have done it, declares the Lord.*

Before God gave the whole nation the word, God had already fulfilled the word in the spirit realm (see verses 7-10). Ezekiel saw in the spirit realm a vast army, he saw bones, tendons, flesh and skin appear and joined together to make figures of people, and he saw them come to life

in the spirit realm.

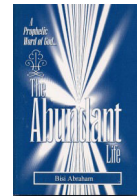
Take a closer look at the last sentence of verse 14, "... Then you will know that I the Lord have spoken, **and I have done it**, declares the Lord." Praise God for the Zeal of the Lord who brings to pass every word of God! So, remember that every word of God in the Bible is already existing in the spirit realm and God sees them as already fulfilled (see Romans 4:17).

## Faith in the Word of God, the key to life

Ezekiel spoke and gave them the word of God (Ezekiel 37:12-14). As they heard the message, they be-

lieved. So, faith in its physical fulfillment was birthed in them. The Bible says: *"So then faith cometh by hearing and hearing by the word of God."* (Romans 10:17, KJV)

**Scriptural reference:** *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

**Scriptural reference:** *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
