A Word In Season

"Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am. [14] If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet. [15] For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you." (John 13:13-15)

Be More Than Just A Believer In Jesus; Be His Disciple Indeed!

"Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; [32] And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." (John 8:31-32)

A close look at the above scripture clearly shows that Jesus is not satisfied by people merely believing in Him as their Saviour. Rather, He wants believers in Him to progress to the next stage of becoming His Disciples! Now, a genuine disciple of Jesus is one who continues in His Word diligently in order to know THE TRUTH and be personally disciplined by it as revealed by Jesus Christ Himself. This then enables the disciple to become a true follower walking in the footsteps of his Master, Jesus Christ, in all things. In the same way, as Jesus prayed in John 17:17 -"Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is

truth." - a true Christian is one who is sanctified (i.e. set apart) by THE TRUTH, which is THE WORD OF GOD. In other words, a true Christian lives by the Word of God so that everyone can see the fruit of obedience to God's instructions in his/ her life and reckon that he/she is a Christian indeed (Acts 4:13). Also, Jesus said *a tree is* known by its fruit (Luke 6:44) and that we shall discern true from false prophets by their fruits! (Matthew 7:15-20). Furthermore, it is God-kind of fruit that God seeks from us as His children (John 15:8) and on the day of judgment only our Godly fruit will count! (Matthew 7:21-23) Finally, just as fruit develops naturally from seed that is sown, the fruit of Christ-likeness will similarly develop from the Word of God that we continually sow into our hearts as Jesus' Disciples indeed!

Being A Christian Involves Walking As Jesus Christ Walked While On Earth!

"He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked." (1 John 2:6)

Genuine Christianity is not a lip service! Rather it is "walking as Christ walked." This means that a serious Christian needs to diligently study the Bible to personally know how Jesus walked, during His earthly ministry, so as to be able to imitate Him. For instance, the Bible says that Jesus came to do the Will of God, not His own (John 4:34; 5:30; 6:38; Luke 22:42) and similarly demands the same thing from us as Christians (Matthew 7:21; 12:50; Ephesians 6:6; 1 Peter 4:1-2; 1 John 2:15-17). So, be like Jesus choose to do God's will!

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

Verses 7 and 8 say: "So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. I looked, and tendons and flesh appeared on them and skin covered them, but there was no breath in them."

As he was *sowing* the word of God, he could see in the spirit realm the seed already growing. All the disjointed fabric and parts of the nation of Israel was put together again the structure was in place but not yet functional. Before Christ came to die for us, we were all like the dry bones that Ezekiel saw in his vision. But after Christ came into our lives God began a process of repair and restoration, particularly through His words that we declare out of our mouths. God's words are the building blocks of our lives!

Verses 9 and 10 say, "Then He said to me, prophesy to the breath; prophesy Son of man, and say to it, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe into these slain, that they may live' So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath entered them; they came to life and stood up on their feet - a vast army." Ezekiel was instructed by god **to continue to sow** the seed of the word given to him at every stage. That is, he had to continue to declare the word of God.

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
