## A Word In Season

*“Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. [36] For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.” (Hebrews 10:35-36)*

## The Promises Of God, Your Patience, And Their Fulfillment!

*“For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he swore by himself, [14] Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. [15] And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise.” (Hebrews 6:13-15)*

Usually, between the time that we receive God’s Word with faith, and the time that we actually experience its physical manifestation, there is a period of waiting patiently. We must clearly understand that Faith AND Patience are simultaneously required in order to experience fulfillment of the Word

of God in this physical realm. In Hebrews 6:12 the Bible teaches us that it is through faith and patience that we inherit the promises of God. Furthermore, in Hebrews 10:36 the Bible says that we NEED patience, after we have done the will of God (i.e. after we have had faith) before we can



*“For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.” (Hebrews 10:36)*

RECEIVE the promise! The scriptural truth is that patience is needed to ensure that we do not lack anything! This is clear in

James 1:4 - *“But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.”* In other words, there is a need for us to let (allow) patience complete its work in us so that we may be entire (completely whole) without lacking anything! Therefore, resolve that no matter the circumstance, when you have believed God’s Word regarding your need, you will never give up. Instead, you will keep standing your ground in faith and prayer while waiting patiently for God to fulfill the promise in the physical. Remember that God’s Word is already settled in Heaven (Psalm 119:89), all you are waiting for is its physical fulfillment here on earth!

## Understand That God Has An Appointed Time For The Fulfillment Of His Word!

*“For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.” (Habakkuk 2:3)*

As God said to Habak-

kuk in the scripture quoted above, His Vision (His Word) is for AN APPOINTED TIME. This truth is also clear in the rebuke God gave Zacharia for not believing His Word: *“And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the*

*day that these things shall be performed, because thou believest not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season.” (Luke 1:20).* So, be prepared to always wait for the appointed time that God has chosen to fulfill His Word in your life!

# Confess The Word Of Hope Always

Let's open to Ezekiel 37:11-14. Before we read it, let's lay a little bit of foundation. We all know that in Ezekiel 36:26-27 there is promise of us being born again, the old sinful spirit removed, and a new spirit as well as the Spirit of God put in us, so that we could obey God. Remember the Spirit He put in us is also the Spirit of Grace. The Spirit of God is filled with power to do Truth; to do the Word of God. And so, what we lack to obey God has been supplied by the Spirit of God. And again, we see the same thing in Ezekiel 37:1-14, the promise there of raising us up from the dead and putting His Spirit within us, helping us to obey Him. And so we see similarities in the two

chapters. But what we have all failed to realise is that after the born-again experience in these two chapters, there are also promises for the believer, for the one whom He has raised up. God did not just raise us up from the dead and put His Spirit in us and that's the end. No, He still has a lot of things for us. Remember when He delivered Israel from Egypt. He did not just leave them there; He led them to the Promised Land where they lived happily. And we give God all the glory that He is the same yesterday, today and forever. He will not leave you and I

midway. He that started a good work in us is faithful to continue that work and bring it to His own expected end. And we all know that He says: *Beloved I will above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health even as thy soul prospereth.* And so you see, He wants a good end for us, even here on earth. His thoughts, His plans, His will, for you and I are good, not evil.

**Scriptural reference:** *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

**Scriptural reference:** *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
