A Word In Season

Do You Know The All-conquering Power Of God's Love?

"That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, [18] May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; [19] And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God." (Ephesians 3:17-19)

Often times we desire to experience the Power of God in our lives but lack the basic understanding that in order to successfully do so we need to KNOW (Ephesians 3:19) and BELIEVE (1 John 4:16) and WALK IN (Ephesians 5:2) THE LOVE OF GOD! We need to understand that GOD IS LOVE (1 John 4:16) i.e. Love is the Nature of God and His Power flows out of His Nature! <u>Without Love God's Power</u> <u>cannot operate</u>! This is why the Bible says that Faith, which is a powerful attribute of God that can move "mountains" (Mark 11:22-23) only works by Love! (Galatians 5:6).



"And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God." (Ephes. 3:19)

Everything God does is motivated by Love, for example, John 3:16 and that is why we must imitate Him as his dear children!

- 1. KNOW the Love of God by meditating on the characteristics of it as revealed in the Bible (1 Corinthians 13:4-8)
- 2. BELIEVE the Love of God by trusting wholeheartedly on its "unfailing" nature (1 Corinthians 13:8; Romans 8:35-39)
- 3. WALK IN the Love of God by obeying God's word as contained in the Holy Bible (John 14:21-24).

Doing the above 3 things will enable you to personally experience God's Power at work in all aspects of your life and circumstances!

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Love Is The Character That Shows That We Are Christians!

"By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another." (John 13:35)

According to the above scripture, the key thing that shows everyone that we are Christians is our love for one another, not our garments, the bibles we carry, our sanctimonious looks, etc. Jesus said those words and so that is THE TRUTH! He also said that all the law and prophets (i.e. everything that God has ever been saying to mankind) hang on the commandment to LOVE God and one's fellow human being (Matthew 22:37-40). The Bible further teaches us that LOVE is what we "owe" each other in fulfilling God's law! (Romans 13:8-10)

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit made the whole structure to come together when Ezekiel prophesied initially, so they had life already, but at the second instance they had it more abundantly.

It is therefore vitally important that we activate the presence of the Holy Spirit always, so that we may continually abide in the presence of the Lord, thereby enjoying His abundant life in increasing measures day by day (John 10:10; 1 Corinthians 3:6-7)

Verse 11 says, "Then He said to me Son of man these bones are the whole house of Israel. They say, 'our bones are dried up and our hope is gone; We are cut off." The dry bones represent their status at that time and they also confessed it. **"They say"** represents their own confession. God never made them like that. That state came about as a result of their sins (see Amos 8:1-3). They sowed evils seeds and nurtured and partook of the fruits of evil. Now they saw their state and repented. God listened and began the process of restoration.

Verse 12 says, **Therefore prophesy and say to them:** This is what the Sovereign Lord says: o my people, I am going to open your graves and bring you up from them; I will bring you back to the land of Israel.

For restoration and well-being they

had to change their confession and sow good seeds (i.e. the word of God). So, God gave them His word to replace their former status.

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
