God has given us His Prophetic Word to run with this year ...

2020 - God Will Perfect It For You (Psalm 138:8; Hebrews 13:20-21)

So remember to wage a good warfare with it in your daily prayers! (1 Timothy 1:18)



"For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: [11] So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void. but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." (Isaiah 55:10-11)

Remember Your Covenant Blessings In Jesus Christ!

"Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. [2] Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: [3] Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; [4] Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; [5] Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's." (Psalm 103:1-5)

Just like David did in Psalm 103:2, we need to constantly challenge our souls (mind, will and emotions) to bless the Lord Jesus Christ and not forget the benefits of salvation that He has freely purchased for us by His sacrifice on the Cross of Calvary. This is because our souls are easily distracted by the troubles of life that we go through in this world, and if not disciplined to focus on THE TRUTH (the Word of God)



"Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:" (Psalm 103:2)

it can resort to rationalising based on human wisdom and personal understanding. Deliberately focusing our thoughts on

the Word of God helps our souls to not forget THE TRUTH, which we need in order to personally experience the freedom wherewith Jesus Christ has already made us free (see John 8:31-32). This is further emphasised by the Bible in James 1:25 where it says: "But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in *his deed."* The primary key to ensuring that we don't forget the promises of God is to meditate in His Word (The Bible) regularly as God encouraged Joshua to do in Joshua 1:8. This is the scriptural pre-requisite to becoming blessed as a doer of the Word of God.

Rest Assured That God Will Never Break His Covenant!

"My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips." (Psalm 89:34)

God never breaks His Covenant or fail to keep His Promises! We are the ones who often fail to keep our own side of the Covenant Agreement, for example, by failing to OBEY God (see Deuteronomy 28:1-14) and by failing to live by FAITH (see Hebrews 11:6). God's eyes are always upon His Word to perform it (Jeremiah 1:12). Similarly, God's eyes are always searching for people whose hearts obey His Word so that He might show Himself strong on their behalf (see 2 Chronicles 16:9). Therefore, rest assured that God will not fail to perform His promises, if you obey Him.

Faith That Speaks The Word Of Promise Only

Let's read Romans 4:16-17 -"Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were." Amen, in Jesus name. And so again we see: "therefore it is of faith that it might be by grace". We all know Romans 5:1-2 says by faith we have access into grace. And grace is the

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
