A Word In Season

"The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles. [18] The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. [19] Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all." (Psalm 34:17-19)

The Tremendous Power Of Praying Effectually & Fervently

"Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much. [17] Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. [18] And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit." (James 5:16-18)

Any Christian who prays effectually (scripturally) and fervently (perseveringly) will experience the tremendous power of God in response to his or her prayers, just as Elijah did. The key to Elijah's powerful prayer was his willingness to pray perseveringly according to God's Word that came to him (see 1 Kings 17:1; 1 Kings 18:1, 41-46). He believed the word that God spoke to him and went into prayer expecting God to perform it. And

in 1 Kings 18:43 when his servant came and said "there is nothing" at first, he refused to doubt or stop praying. Rather, he asked his servant to go back sev-

en times, whilst he continued to pray fervently! Similarly, the key to the widow woman's success in Jesus' parable about unceasing prayer in Luke 18:1-8 was her persistence in demanding justice from the judge. She refused to give up when the judge said "no" initially because she knew that with the law on her side, justice was inevitable! The constant truth is that God's Word is always on our side and God, The Just Judge, never fails to ensure that justice is done in accordance to His word! (Luke 18:7-8). Therefore, in every circumstance, access the Power of God by persevering in prayer while standing steadfastly on the relevant promises in the Bible!

Don't Worry, Don't Panic, Don't Be Discouraged, Just Pray Perseveringly In Faith!

"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God." (Philip. 4:6)

God expects us **not to worry** about anything in

this life. No matter the circumstance, His will for us is to pray and give thanks to Him! Thanking God along with our prayer, even before we see any visible evidence of answered prayer, is our expression of faith in God and His promises on which we base our requests when we pray. Whatever we thank God for in prayer, in line with the relevant promises in His Word, we will surely receive here on earth because His Word is already settled in Heaven for us! (Psalm 119:89).

THE WORD: FOUNDATION OF EVERYTHING

For example, if you don't believe that God created all things and you are still holding on to the "big bang" and "apes being the ancestor of man" theory of evolution, it will be extremely difficult to believe that God can give you a new heart if you have need for one.

As you accept the word, you are receiving it into your spirit, and it grows and **as you continue** to hear the word you start to speak it - your speaking the word is nurturing it and also calling forth the harvest. If you quote the words of God without a prior meditation and understanding, there is no life in it. It will belike one trying to harvest wheat from a land not sowed with wheat, that is reaping where you have not sown - usually thieves do this(see John 10:1) But we are not thieves, we will go through the Living Word of God and find pasture, in Jesus name (see John 10:9)

So we see our Lord Jesus pointing us to the seed, and its outcome when sown, as a means of understanding the way of the Word of God.

The Word: has Life in itself

God spoke out the word for every type of seed in genesis 1:11-12. The word through the Spirit produced the seed. The word through the Spirit also developed the seed into trees and fruits. Speaking is God's method of creating things. This is God's way of bringing forth life and also imparting his ZOE life to the things He has created. (1 John 1:1)

The ZOE Life of God is the essence or the necessary ingredient that makes things what they are and also causes them to exist and function as they are meant to. (John 1:1-4) God also spoke out everything we need on earth and throughout eternity(2 Peter 1:3-4). His promises are in His word. God's word becomes seed in us and fruit for us. That is, bread for the eater and seed for the sower.

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
