# Do Not Forget The Listening Aspect Of Prayer!

"I will stand upon my watch, and set me upon the tower, and will watch to see what he will say unto me, and what I shall answer when I am reproved." (Habakkuk 2:1)

Simply defined, prayer is communicating with God. Just as basic communication involves speaking and listening, so prayer also involves speaking to God and listening to Him. This truth is clearly revealed in Habakkuk 2:1 quoted above:

1. "what He will say unto me"

2. "what I shall answer"

Many of us only focus on the aspect of talking to God in prayer but fail to pay attention to the listening aspect whereby we can receive vital instructions from Him to help us know what we need to do,



"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me." (John 10:27)

on our own part, in order to have the victory or success that we desire in the time of need. In fact, it was Habakkuk's resolve to listen to what God would answer him in his prayer that helped him to know what to do in the circumstance (see Habakkuk 2:2-3). Similarly, it was David's willingness to listen to God in prayer that enabled him to receive God's detailed instructions necessary for him to follow in order to gain victory over the philistines who came to battle against him time and time again (see 1 Chronicles 14:8-16).

To develop the listening aspect of prayer, we must constantly spend time meditating in the Word of God (Holy Bible) and praying in the Holy Spirit (Unknown Tongues). This is because the primary way God speaks to us by His Spirit is through His written Word (see John 5:39; 15:26; 14:25-26; 16:12-14).

# Allow The Holy Spirit To Train Your Hears To Hear God Clearly!

"He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches." (Revelation 3:13)

Ears that are capable of hearing from God, by the help of the Holy Spirit, is one of the privileges that Christians have. Hence, Jesus says: "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me." (John 10:27) But in order for our spiritual ears to hear clearly we must let the Holy Spirit train and develop

them by diligently spending time meditating the Word of God and praying in the Holy Spirit. This is why Isaiah 50:4 says - "... he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned." So, allow Him to train your ears to hear God clearly!

# THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

The river of faith had been flowing even before the foundation of the world and in every generation, God raised people to keep it flowing.

Be like the Shunammite woman who, despite having a dead son at home, confessed out "it is well with me." (2 Kings 4:8-37, KJV). Note what she did. She insisted that the prophet of God must go with her and nobody else. Same way too, Moses insisted on the Lord's presence to come with him (Exodus 33:1-15). This Shunammite woman and Moses knew something. They knew the power of God's presence that comes through persistent faith!

The presence of the Lord guaranteed the ZOE Life of God that was necessary to bring to pass, in the life of her son, the words "it is well with me." It was cer-

tainly well with her son. The Lord's presence through His prophet gave life to the boy. Also, the Lord continued to lead Israel by a pillar of cloud by day and the pillar of fire by night - Israel occupied the promised land because of the ZOE Life of God (Exodus 13:21-22).

### Must keep sowing the Word of God

Words produce fruits. Evil words are evil seeds and produce evil fruits. The parables of Jesus make this very clear and also convey some other truth.

Let's look at some verses of Matthew chapter 13, Verse 24 says, Jesus told them another parable: "The kingdom of

heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field."

Remember, earlier we said that the se-

cret of the Kingdom has been given to us believers, and that secret is the revealed word of God. Now, here Jesus says the Kingdom is like a man who sowed good seed ...see the pattern again? In God's Kingdom you must sow the word of God. The unique feature of the Kingdom of God is that the word of God is sowed and that it operates on the Word of God.

  personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who
  worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
