A Word In Season

"But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him." (Hebrews 11:6)

Ensure That You Walk In Ways That Please God!

"When a man's ways please the Lord, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him." (Proverbs 16:7)

Everyday each one of us is faced with situations that warrant making a personal choice to either please God or self. This is because of the conflict between the flesh and the spirit in each one of us (see Romans 7:14-23; Galatians 5:16-17). Therefore, learning to make the right choices to please God is of vital importance if we are to enjoy the very best of God's divine help in all aspects of our lives. Furthermore, God's desire for each one of us is that

our personal choices to please Him would regularly abound in our lives. This is what the bible clearly teaches us in 1 Thessalonians 4:1 -"Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have re-

ceived of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more." The fundamental truth is that the choices we make, rather than the circumstances per se, are what determine our ultimate outcome in

every circumstance of life. This is why Proverbs 16:7 quoted above emphasizes a focus on pleasing God instead of what the enemy could do. David also said in Psalm 23:5 that God blessed him in the presence of his enemies! In other words, his enemies could not stop his blessings! Whenever our ways please God, no enemy can successfully hinder us because God Himself will be our defense in such cases! Finally, the key to pleasing God is to spend quality time studying the Bible to learn the ways that God says we should walk and respond with personal obedience. This is synonymous to Faith - hearing the Word of God and doing it! (see Romans 10:17 and James 1:22).

Say NO To The Flesh And YES To The Spirit In Order To Please God!

"Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. [8] So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God." (Romans 8:7-8) Pleasing God requires saying NO to the flesh and YES to the Spirit whenever we are faced with situations that demand choosing between pleasing self or pleasing God. To successfully do this we need the help of the Holy Spirit! This is why Romans 8 quoted above goes on to say in verse 13 that it is through the Spirit that we mortify the deeds of the flesh! Therefore spend quality time studying the Word of God and praying in the Holy Spirit (Jude 20-21).

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

One unique thing is that in every generation of the Jews, there are those who keep the word spoken by the prophets before their eyes and they chant these words in prayer (Deuteronomy 11:18-21). They stand in the gap for the whole nation (Read Numbers 13:30, 14:24; 1 Kings 19:13,14,18; Nehemiah 1; Daniel 9:1-20; Luke 2:25-38 and Romans 11:1-6). They never stop confessing out these words of God! So the word of God will continue to come to pass in Israel.

In the same way too, the word of God will produce fruit forever and ever in the lives of the spiritual Israelites, that is the Body of Christ. Those who continue to sow the word of God into their lives will receive and continue to enjoy the promises of God, despite persecutions, trials and tribulations, etc. (Read Galatians 3:14, 26-29).

So it is a choice to remain as part of the Body of Christ and produce fruit required of God. You make that choice by sowing the word of God, daily, into every area of your life. If you don't you will be lagging behind in reaping your rightful inheritance as a child of God. In other words, you are indirectly cutting yourself off from the Abundant Life of God (Romans 11:17-24; John 15:1-8; Matthew 21:33-43).

If you continue to sow evil seeds (e.g. words of failure, lack, poverty, inability, jealousies, hatred, malice, etc.) you will eventually be destroyed because they will grow and you will reap the fruits of evil in your life. If this happens, then it means that you are not producing the good fruit required of God - just as a whole generation of Israelites was cut off, leaving only Caleb and Joshua in the time of Moses - because they were not keeping the word before their eyes and mind, therefore they **lacked faith** to believe that His promise would come to pass (Numbers 13 &14).

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
