A Word In Season

"Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: [9] Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world." (1 Peter 5:8-9)

Always Guard Against Spiritual Complacency!

"Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall." (1 Corinthians 10:12)

Complacency is a major trap the Devil sets for Christians to make them fall. In fact, no matter how 'spiritual' we think we are as Christians, we are all prone to falling into complacency if we do not guard against it! 1 Corinthians 10:12 quoted above, if studied in context from verse 1, is a warning against complacency. In verses 6 and 11 we are admonished to clearly understand that the examples given from verses 1-10 are for our 'learning' so that we may not fall into complacency

as they fell into it and ended up displeasing God.

The Webster's dictionary defines complacency as: "self-satisfaction especially when accompanied by unawareness of actual dangers or defi-

ciencies." In other words it is a false sense of safety or security that ultimately results in a fall or defeat!

There are many examples in the Bible of people who suffered greatly because of

complacency. David, for instance, committed adultery with Bathsheba because of complacency (see 2 Samuel 11:1-27). He also made the costly mistake of wrongly taking a census of Israel because of complacency (see 1 Chronicles 21:1-7) Another notable example is Samson who had an affair with Delilah that eventually brought him to ruins (see Judges 16:1-20).

In order to guard against complacency, each one of us must take personal responsibility to always:

- 1. Take heed to God's Word (Hebrews 2:1)
- 2. Pray in the Holy Spirit (Jude 17-21)

Be Watchful, Be Prayerful Always!

"Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." (Matthew 26:41)

In order to successfully overcome the weakness

of the flesh and walk in the Spirit, thereby pleasing God, we must heed the instruction that our Lord Jesus Christ gave to His disciples in Matthew 26:41 as quoted above. Furthermore, Jesus repeats a similar injunction in Luke 21:3436 where He clearly teaches us that the key to not being overwhelmed <u>at any time</u> by the lusts of the flesh is to watch and pray <u>always</u>! Finally, the way to watch and pray is by constantly abiding in the Word of God and prayer!

THE WORD: ALREADY SETTLED IN THE SPIRIT

Remember the parable of the ten virgins in Matthew chapter 25 - the foolish ones ran out of oil because they were asleep, not only in their flesh but also in their spirit. Meditating in the word of faith day and night, alongside the brethren, keeps the oil flowing. They were not constantly in the presence of God and the Holy Spirit. So it is you who will benefit now and throughout all eternity, if you don't forsake the assembling together of the saints - "For I long to see you, that I may impart unto you some spiritual gift, to the end you may be established; That is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual faith both of you and me." (Romans 1:11,12, KJV)

Several times Israel was exiled in the

past, and even recently the nation of Israel was restored in 1948, after a trying period, which included the holocaust. No matter what comes against Israel in the future their status will forever be this: 'God calls them and sees them as a vast army and blessed in their own land (the promised land) for ever and ever.' Even in the newly created heaven and earth, Israel will be in their land a vast army and blessed. (Read Revelation 21:1-2; 7:1-8, and Romans 11:1-6; 11:25 -32; 2:10-11)

The word spoken over Israel, through prophet Ezekiel, reflects how Israel is in the spirit realm, and it will always come to bear on the physical, no matter what. "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away." (Matt. 24:35) It is amazing what the word of God says in Romans chapter 11 verse 29 *"For God's gifts and His call are irrevocable."* Israel will reap the fruit of these words for ever and ever.

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
