A Word In Season

"But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. [58] Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord." (1 Cor. 15:57-58) "Moreover the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, Jeremiah, what seest thou? And I said, I see a rod of an almond tree. [12] Then said the Lord unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it." (Jeremiah 1:11-12)

To every circumstance of life there are two main perspectives - GOD and HUMAN. In other words, we can either 'see' our circumstance from God's perspective or from our human perspective. In the scripture quoted above, God said to Jeremiah: 'Thou hast well seen' because he saw exactly as God saw. It was as a result of Jeremiah's correct vision that God promised to hasten His Word to perform it. This is the key thing about walking by faith - the ability to

see things God's way (2 Corinthians 5:7) It is also why walking by faith is the only way to please God (Hebrews 11:6) Genuine Faith relies absolutely on God's perspective without any recourse to our human understanding! (Proverbs 3:5) Unlike Human's perspective that is solely based on natural intellect, God's perspective is always based on His Word as already SETTLED in Heaven and WRITTEN in the Holy Bible (Psalm 119:89; Romans 15:4) Hence, we need to study the Bible DILIGENTLY and fix our eyes/heart on its promises so as to 'see' as God 'sees' (Proverbs 4:20-22) For instance, if we are sick we have to study/meditate God's promises regarding healing until they become the only thing we 'see' instead of the sickness. Whenever our perspective agrees with God's own. He will certainly perform His Word in our circumstance! (Jeremiah 1:12, Amos 3:3)

Be Not Afraid, Only Believe!

"While he yet spake, there came from the ruler of the synagogue's house certain which said, Thy daughter is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further? [36] As soon as Jesus heard the word

that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only believe." (Mark 5:35-36)

At times, in our walk of faith, the situation may go from bad to worse! During such times, we must remember what Jesus said to Jairus and choose to KEEP ON BE-LIEVING God's Word, rather than succumb to the Devil's plan to paralyse our faith with fear! Whenever fear comes knocking, TRUST GOD! (Psalm 56:3)


THE WORD: FOUNDATION OF EVERYTHING

Let's take a first look at these verses of scripture to examine some basic truths. We will take another look later.

"As the rain and the snow come down from heaven, and do not return to it without watering the earth and making it bud and flourish, so that it yields seed for the sower and bread for the eater, so is my word that goes out from my mouth: it will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it." The Lord likens **His word to a seed** which when planted (by speaking it out of our mouths) will produce fruit after its kind. Our Lord Jesus Christ also confirmed this truth in Luke's account of the parable of the sower. Chapter 8 verse 11 says: "*This is the meaning* of the parable: The seed is the word of God."

In short, God says: learn the way of the seed on earth, then you will understand how powerful my word is; you will understand how to use my word; you will understand how the Kingdom of God operates and you will be able to enjoy the benefits of the Kingdom. Just as every farmer needs to sow a seed before he can reap a harvest of fruits, we need to sow the word in order for us to reap the fruit of the word. ... *continued next month*

"For I am not ashamed of the

gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. [17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith." (Romans 1:16-17)

"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." (Romans 10:17)

[6] And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith. [7] And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? [8] I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?" (Luke 18:1-8)

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
