(Philippians 3:10-11)

Enjoy Christ’s Resurrection Power & Life Everyday!

“Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: [26] And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?” (John 11:25-26)

Every Christian has access to the Resurrection Power and Life of Jesus Christ always. This is because of the SPIRITUAL CONNECTION that Christians have with Jesus. He is the Head and we are His Body. We are joined together with Him by the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 6:17). He is the Vine and we are the Branches (John 15:5). However, in order

to take advantage of our connection to Christ, and enjoy His Resurrection Power and Life, we must BELIEVE and OBEY His Word as contained in the Holy Bible. Faith in the Word of God is the primary key to enjoying the Power and Life of Jesus



“Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life...”
(John 11:25)

Christ because He is the Word of God (John 1:14; Revelation 19:13). Every time that we believe and obey the Word of God, the Holy Spirit is activated and the Life of God is released (John 6:63). And

whenever the Holy Spirit is activated, the Power of Resurrection is in operation because the Holy Spirit is the One who resurrected Jesus from the dead (Romans 8:11). And whenever the Power of Resurrection (The Holy Spirit) is in operation, all the works of devil are destroyed! (John 10:10; 1 John 3:8). Therefore, let us choose to be “doers of God’s Word” day by day, and enjoy the Resurrection Power and Life of Christ always! In Ephesians 1:19-20, Paul prayed that we may experientially know the exceeding greatness of the Power of Resurrection that is available for Believers in Jesus Christ. That ought to be our unceasing daily faith and prayer also!

You Partook With Christ In His Redemptive Work So As To Walk In Newness Of Life!

“Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? [4] Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was

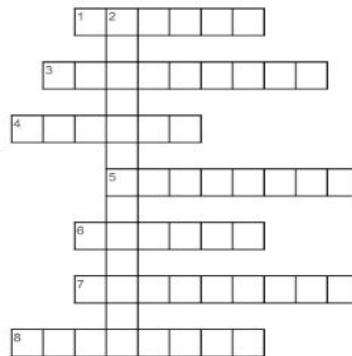
raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.”

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
