A Word In Season

“And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.” (Matthew 17:20)

How To Turn Impossible Situations Around When They Are Contrary To God’s Word

“And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren. ³⁷ For with God nothing shall be impossible.” (Luke 1:36-37)

As long as we are in this world we are going to face naturally impossible situations from time to time. When such situations are contrary to God’s Word we must be determined to have God turn them around according to His Will for us!

In Luke 1:36 quoted above, Elisabeth whom people called barren became a mother according

to God’s Word in Deuteronomy 7:14 that says, *“Thou shalt be blessed above all people; there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.”* This clearly shows that God’s Word is the final authority in our lives!



“And he said, The things which are impossible with men are possible with God.” (Luke 18:27)

God’s Word works with the Power of the Holy Spirit to change contrary situations and line them up with God’s Will for us! However, for this to happen, faith in God’s Word is

required. Hebrews 11:11 says, *“Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.”* Faith is what connects us to the miracle-working Power of God! (see Mark 5:25-34; Luke 5:17,20).

To turn your impossible situations around do the following:

1. Steadfastly believe God’s Word that applies to your need (Mark 9:23; Matthew 17:20)
2. Patiently continue to pray with God’s Word that applies to your need (2 Kings 4:32-35; 1 Kings 17:20-22).

If You Can Truly Believe, All Things Are Possible To You!

“Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.” (Mark 9:23)

Your believing God and His Word, is the basic requirement for experi-

encing God’s Power to supernaturally turn naturally impossible situations around! This is why Jesus said to Martha at the tomb of Lazarus, *“..., Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldst believe, thou shouldst see the glory of God?”*

(Luke 11:40). The kind of believing that God requires of us is a wholehearted one. Hence, Proverbs 3:5 says, *“Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.”* Choose to trust in God always!

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
