A Word In Season

“Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: [31] But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.” (Isaiah 40:30-31)

Wait Upon The Lord And Live Victoriously!

“I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living. [14] Wait on the Lord: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the Lord.” (Psalm 27:13-14)

A close look the scripture quoted above reveals a vital key to victorious Christian living. In verse 13, the Psalmist says that he would have fainted (i.e. given up) if he had not chosen to believe (i.e. have faith) in God to turn things around for good. And in verse 14, he shows us that the way he successfully expressed his faith to see the goodness of God in

the land of the living was by “waiting on the Lord” to receive Strength from God! The Bible clearly teaches us that the Strength of God is the only strength that never fails! Human strength (the arm of flesh) will always fail (see Isaiah

40:28-31; Jeremiah 17:5-8). Hence we must always depend on God’s Strength to live victoriously in this life. And this Strength of God comes by “waiting on the Lord.” Now, what does

it mean to wait upon the Lord? Simply put, to wait upon the Lord is to look to Him in patient expectation. It involves absolute dependence or reliance on God. And how do you wait upon the Lord? Firstly, you wait upon the Lord by studying and meditating the Word of God, giving your whole attention to it (Proverbs 4:20-22). Secondly, you wait upon the Lord by praying (with or without fasting) to God with a full heart devotion (Matthew 6:6). Thirdly, you wait upon the Lord by praising and worshipping God with a sincere heart in full adoration and devotion (Psalm 138:1-2). So, regularly wait upon the Lord, access His Strength, and live victoriously! (Isaiah 40:31).

Challenge Your Soul To Expectantly Wait Upon God Alone!

“My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him. [6] He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved.” (Psalm 62:5-6)

Challenging your soul to

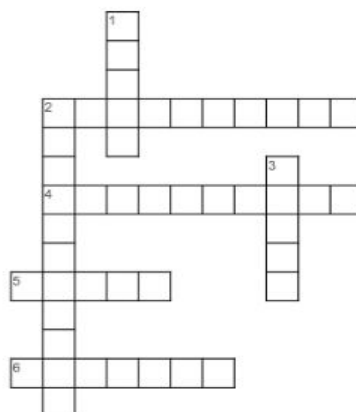
“wait upon God” is necessary for it to be anchored in hope while your faith is at work to obtain the victory that you desire from God. Faith and hope work together. The Bible says that, *“Faith is the substance of things hoped*

for.” (Hebrews 11:1). In other words, Faith which is *“the victory that overcomes the world” (1 John 5:4)* needs hope to function! Therefore, challenge your soul to hopefully “wait upon God” by focusing your thoughts on God’s Word only!

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."* (3 John 2).

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *"And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God."* (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *"But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth."* (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
