# Agape Love - The All-Powerful Fruit Of The Holy Spirit!

"Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away." (1 Corinthians 13:8)

Many Christians pursue the Gifts of the Holy Spirit as the ultimate source of God's Power. But according to the Bible, the Gifts of the Holy Spirit don't operate all the time because they flow only "as the Spirit wills" (see 1 Corinthians 12:11). On the other hand, Agape, the Godkind of Love, which is the Fruit of the Holy Spirit, can be activated

and put into operation at any time <u>as the individual</u> <u>Christian wills!</u> This is because walking in the Love of God is a personal choice (see Galatians 5:16). In fact, every time you choose to obey the Word of God, the Love of God is released! This is



"And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ." (2 Thessalonians 3:5)

because obedience to the Word of God and the Love of God are interconnected. That is why Jesus said, "If ye love me, keep my commandments." (John 14:15).

Now, according to 1 Corinthians 13:8, whereas the Gifts of the Spirit may fail, Love, the Fruit of the Spirit, never fails! This shows the superiority of the Fruit of the Spirit to the Gifts of the Spirit as a never-failingsource of God's Power! Agape Love can be relied upon in every situation to accomplish the Perfect Will of God! It never fails! Hallelujah! Therefore, give all diligence to choosing to walk in Agape Love, which according to 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 is long-suffering, kind, not envious, not arrogant or proud, not rude, not selfish, not easily provoked, and thinks no evil, bears all things, endures all things, and never fails! When you do so, you'll never fail to access the Power of God!

## Walking In Agape Love Makes You Perfect As God Is Perfect!

"Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect." (Matthew 5:48)

In the above scripture, Jesus challenges us to be perfect as God is perfect! And He teaches us how to do so in the preceding verses (verses 43-47) where He clearly shows us that the God-kind of Love (Agape) is the way to be perfect as God is perfect. In those verses, he distinguishes Agape Love from the flimsy,

preferential love that the devil counterfeits among the people of the world. Agape Love is consistent and unconditional! In Colossians 3:14, it is described as "the bond of perfectness." So, walk in Agape Love, and be perfect as God is perfect!

thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach;" (Romans 10:6-8)

"We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;" (2 Corinthians 4:13)

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
