"Then shall ye call upon me, and ye shall go and pray unto me, and I will hearken unto you. [13] And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart."
(Jeremiah 29:12-13)

Praying & Fasting The Way That Pleases God

"And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward." (Matthew 6:5)

"Moreover when ye fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward." (Matthew 6:16)

In both of the scriptures quoted above regarding

praying and fasting, Jesus teaches us to avoid hypocrisy. In other words, we must ensure that we pray and fast from a heart of sincere devotion to God! This is because God is never pleased nor will he ever accept anything we offer to Him except we offer it with all our heart!

PRAYER FASTING

"And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:13)

Furthermore, Jesus quoting the prophecy of Isaiah said, "Ye hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying, [8] This people draweth nigh unto me

with their mouth, and honoureth me with their lips; but their heart is far from me." (Matthew 15:7-8). Also, "And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:13). God wants sincere hearts in full devotion whenever we seek to fellowship with Him! Now, a sincere heart is a heart of obedience. That is why the Bible says, "... to obey is better than sacrifice..." (1 Samuel 15:22). This is also what the Bible teaches us in Isaiah 58:1-14 about the kind of fasting that God accepts, and in 1 John 3:20-22 about the kind of prayer that receives an answer from God. Therefore, as we pray and fast this month let us seek God with sincere hearts!


If You Delight Yourself In God's Word He Will Give You Your Heart's Desires!

"Delight thyself also in the Lord; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart." (Psalm 37:4)

As you seek God with prayer and fasting this month, choose to make the Word of God your number one desire. This is because when you put God's Word first in your life, God will bless you with the blessings He reserves for those who obey Him! (see Psalm 1:1-3; Psalm 112:1-10). Delighting yourself in the Word of God is the number one way of honouring God because God Himself has magnified His Word above all His name (see Psalm 138:2). Be like Job who esteemed God's Word more than his necessary food (Job 23:12)!

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and
 personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who
 worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
