Be More Conscious Of God Inside Of You Than The World Outside!

"Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? (1 Cor. 3:16)

"Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world." (1 John 4:4)

As a Christian, the truth is that you are in the world but not of the world (John 17:14-16). You are of God, and God dwells in you (1 John 4:4; 1 Corinthians 3:16). Furthermore, the Bible says that the Kingdom of God is within you! (Luke

17:21). Also, greater is God who is in you than he that is in the world! (1 John 4:4). Therefore, your consciousness ought to be more focused on the Greater God who is inside of you than the lesser world that is outside of you! The truth is that



"... greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4)

what you focus on will affect your thinking, and your thinking will determine your outcomes in life! (Proverbs 23:7). A good example of this can be clearly seen in the biblical account of the twelve

spies that Moses sent to spy out the Promised Land (see Numbers 13). Ten of them were more conscious of the giants in the land and focused their thoughts on them rather than God. Those ten spies never made it into the Promised Land. On the other hand, two of the twelve spies (Joshua and Caleb) were more conscious of God and focused their thoughts on Him instead of the giants they saw in the land. These two spies succeeded in possessing the Promised Land! In conclusion, the key to ensuring that your consciousness is focused on God in you rather than the world outside, is to constantly meditate in the Word of God until it becomes the main focus of your thoughts always!

If God Be For You, Who Can Be Against You?

"What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31)

A personal revelation of the truth that the Al-



- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and
 personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who
 worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
