A Word In Season

"And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? [8] I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?" (Luke 18:7-8)

Keep On Asking, Seeking, And Knocking In Prayer!

"Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: [8] For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened." (Matthew 7:7-8)

The encouragement to ask, seek, and knock, in the scripture quoted above, is written in present continuous tense. In other words, we are to CONTINUALLY ask or seek or knock until we obtain the desired endresult! The fundamental truth about prayer that is offered to God in faith (see James 1:5-6), and according to God's will (see 1 John 5:14-15), is that such prayer will

always receive an answer from God, if the person offering it does not give up! (see Luke 18:1-8). Jesus clearly taught this truth using the parable of the widow woman and the unjust judge in Luke 18:1-8. Therefore, just like the widow woman, we need to

have the same mindset of never giving up when we are praying to God! In order to do this successfully, we must ensure that our prayers are offered in faith and according to God's will by basing them on the Word of God. The Bible teaches us that faith comes by means of the Word of God (Romans 10:17) and that the Will of God is done by means of His Word (Psalm 40:8). Therefore, it is necessary for us to diligently spend time studying and meditating the Word of God so that we may build up our faith and ability to do the Will of God by it. Furthermore, since the Word of God never fails (Joshua 21:45; Joshua 23:14; 1 Kings 8:56; Isaiah 55:9-11; Luke 21:33), it follows that anything based on God's Word will never fail! So keep on asking, seeking, and knocking in Word-of-God-based-prayer. Your answer will surely come! AMEN!

Your Effectual Fervent Prayer Will Surely Avail Much!

"Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." (James 5:16)

The scripture quoted



- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
