A Word In Season


“These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.” (John 16:33)

Don't Forget That God Is With You In The Time Of Trouble!

“God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.” (Psalm 46:1)

As a Christian, one key truth you have to remember always is that God is right there with you in whatever trouble you encounter in this world. Unlike man, God never leaves you nor forsake you when you are in trouble. Just like Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the fiery furnace (Daniel 3:24-25), and Daniel in the lion's den (Daniel 6:16-23), God goes into the trouble with you in order to get you out of it! Hallelujah! Furthermore, as it is written, *“When thou passest through the wa-*

ters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.” (Isaiah 43:2). Again, this clearly shows that God is with you in

your trouble! Now, not only is God with you in your trouble, He also wants to get you out of it! That is why He says, *“And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee,*

and thou shalt glorify me.” (Psalm 50:15). God is so loving and so caring! Hallelujah!

Finally, to experience God's help in time of trouble, do the following:

1. Have faith in God and trust in His faithfulness to always keep His promise of never leaving you nor forsaking you in the time of trouble (see Isaiah 43:1-2; Psalm 46:1; Hebrews 10:23).
2. Pray, asking God to deliver you out of the trouble, and praise Him in anticipation of the deliverance (see (Psalm 50:14-15; Psalm 34:1-6, 17-19; Acts 16:25-26).

Keep Your Heart Trouble-free By Believing God And His Word!

“Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.” (John 14:1)

In the above scripture, Jesus said, “Let not your heart be troubled.” The word “let” means “allow”.

Therefore, Jesus is helping you to understand that it is your responsibility to choose to do so! In the time of trouble, if you choose to meditate on the trouble, your heart will be troubled. But if you choose to meditate on God and His

Word, your heart won't be troubled, and you'll be able to overcome the trouble by your faith (1 John 5:4). What you meditate on will fill your heart, and what fills your heart will determine your outcomes in life! (Proverbs 23:7).

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
