A Word In Season

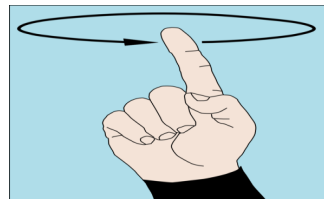

[7] Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it.” (Zechariah 4:6-7)

The Holy Spirit Shall Turn It Around For You!

“The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; [2] To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; [3] To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord,

that he might be glorified.” (Isaiah 61:1-3)

A close look at the above scripture clearly reveals that the Holy Spirit is the Power of God that turns contrary situations around to line them up with the Will of God! He

can turn the ashes of defeat into beauty of victory! He can turn mourning into joy and praise! He can turn captivity to liberty! There is nothing too hard (Genesis 18:14, Jere-

miah 32:17,27) or impossible with Him (Luke 1:37). And as it is written in Mark 9:23, *“If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”* In other words, faith is all that is required to get the Holy Spirit to turn impossible things around and make them possible for the believer. Furthermore, as Jesus said in Matthew 17:20, *“If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.”* Therefore, just as Mary, the mother of Jesus did, choose to trust God and surrender to His Word, and the Holy Spirit will perform it for you! (Luke 1:38,45).

The Spirit Of God Is Your HELPER Against The Enemy!

“So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.”

(Isaiah 59:19)

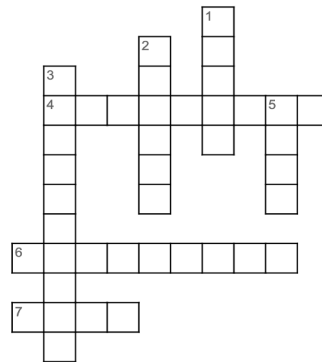
Whatever the trouble that the enemy (the devil) brings against you, the Holy Spirit is always available to help you gain the victory. He will give you the specific

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."* (3 John 2).

Scriptural reference: *"And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God."* (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *"But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth."* (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
