A Word In Season

“For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: ¹¹ So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.” (Isaiah 55:10-11)

Allow Your Faith To Grow Exceedingly!

“We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth;” (2 Thessalonians 1:3)

Whenever faith is allowed to grow steadily, it will eventually grow to the point where it exceeds the need or circumstance that is contrary to the Word of God. It is at this point that faith prevails and the desired victory, success, or breakthrough, comes into manifestation. This is because whenever faith grows to this prevailing-point, the heart becomes fully persuaded

in the Word of God, leaving no room for any unbelief, doubt, or double-mindedness, thereby helping faith to qualify as the righteous-kind-of-faith in the sight of God (see Romans 4:20-22). This is the kind of faith that pleases God (see Hebrews 11:6).



“So mightily grew the Word of God and prevailed.” (Acts 19:20)

So, whenever your faith is wavering, get into the Word of God, and meditate in it long enough to allow yourself to be built up and well grounded in faith, until your faith

grows exceedingly and prevails over your unbelief, doubt, and double-mindedness! (see Colossians 1:23; Colossians 2:6-7). Diligence and patience are required in seeing this growth process through to the end successfully. This is why the Bible says, *“And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: ¹² That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.” (Hebrews 6:11-12)*. Therefore, make a personal choice to keep studying, hearing, and meditating in the Word of God diligently and patiently until your faith grows exceedingly and your heart becomes fully persuaded!

Whenever God’s Word Grows Mightily, It Always Prevails!

“So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.” (Acts 19:20)

Like natural seed that is sown and allowed to grow unto harvest, so will God’s Word sown in

a sincere heart grow unto ‘harvest’, prevailing over everything that is contrary to it! In the Bible, Jesus taught us that the Kingdom of God operates on the principle of seed-sowing and steady growth of the sown-seed unto a sure harvest! (see

Mark 4:26-29). So, whenever you have a need, find out what the Word of God says about that need, and start meditating in it diligently everyday (see Joshua 1:8) until it grows mightily in you, and prevails over the need! It never fails!

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
