A Word In Season

“And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;”
(Revelation 5:9)

Already Redeemed And Made Victorious Over The Devil Through The Blood Of Jesus Christ!

“Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;”
(Psalm 107:2)

“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.”
(Revelation 12:11)

Every believer in Jesus Christ has already been redeemed (set free) and made victorious over the devil forever! When Jesus shed His Blood here on earth, over two thousand years ago, He accomplished in the physical what was already settled in the spirit before the world was creat-

ed (see Revelation 13:8; Hebrews 4:3; Ephesians 1:4; Matthew 25:34). This is a fundamental truth that the devil doesn't want Christians to know because it is a vital key to walking in the liberty which Jesus Christ has purchased for them! (John



8:31-32). Our redemption is already settled through the Blood of Jesus Christ (Colossians 1:12-14; Ephesians 1:7). Therefore, we are not to 'try' to be redeemed or to be victorious. Instead we are to 'enforce'

the redemption and the victory that we already have! This is where faith comes in! Faith is the means by which we enforce, receive, and enjoy the physical manifestation of what already belongs to us in Jesus Christ (Galatians 3:13-14). The Blood of Jesus Christ contains the overcoming LIFE of God! (Leviticus 17:11). Therefore, whenever faith is released in the Blood of Jesus (by believing with the heart and confessing with the mouth - Romans 10:9-10) the LIFE of God is released to overcome the devil and all his evil works! Hence, Psalm 107:2 says: *“Let the redeemed of the Lord SAY so...”* This privilege belongs to every Christian, irrespective of status (Psalm 149:5-9)!

Your Faith In The Blood Of Jesus Christ Will Enable God's Glory To Protect You!

“And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I

smite the land of Egypt.” (Exodus 12:13)

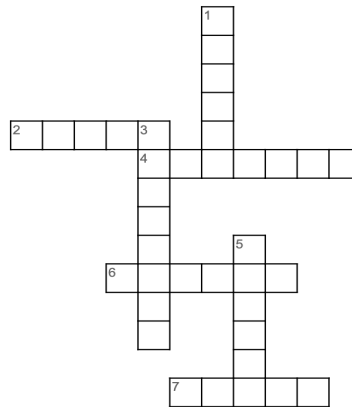
Just as the Israelites had to act in faith and apply the blood of the Passover lamb upon their houses for their

protection, we are to apply the Blood of Jesus Christ over our lives by faith for our protection. Whenever we confess the Blood of Jesus over our lives, in faith, God releases His Glory to cover us and protect us from all manner of evil!

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *“Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.” (3 John 2).*

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
