## A Word In Season

*“Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, <sup>5</sup> Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; <sup>6</sup> Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; <sup>7</sup> Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things.” (1 Corinthians 13:4-7)*

## Always Remember That Love Is What Shows That You Are A True Christian!

*“A new commandment I give unto you, That ye love one another; as I have loved you, that ye also love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.” (John 13:34-35)*

The God-kind of Love, which according to Galatians 5:22 is the Fruit of the Spirit, is the singular character quality that identifies a true Christian. It is the very Nature of God Himself (1 John 4:8) and it is what Jesus came to impart to His followers. As it is written, “Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is

born of God, and knoweth God.

<sup>8</sup> He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love.

<sup>9</sup> In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through

him.” (1 John 4:7-9).

Verse 7 says everyone who shows love is born of God. And verse 8 says anyone who doesn't show

love doesn't know God. And verse 9 says that Jesus is the manifestation of God's love to us. Jesus came to reveal and to impart the love of God to His followers. The bible also says that *“the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit!”*

(Romans 5:5) Therefore, we have the God-kind of Love in us already, we just need to allow it to come out of us in our daily dealings with one another. This requires choosing to ‘deny’ SELF in us, daily, as Jesus said we should do (Luke 9:23) in order to obey God! Love and Obedience to God go together (see John 14:15,21,23,24; John 15:10).

## Love Is The Greatest Of All Available Christian Virtues!

*“And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.” (1 Corinthians 13:13)*

As Christians, our greatest pursuit ought to be

Love. The above scripture says it is the greatest of those three great Christian virtues mentioned there. As much as we pursue faith we have to understand that faith can only work for us to the degree that we choose to walk in love!

Galatians 5:6 says that *“faith works by love.”* Therefore, lack of love will hinder faith! Love is the *“bond of perfectness”* (Colossians 3:14). Love is what binds all other Christian virtues together and makes them work perfectly!

**Scriptural reference:** *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

**Scriptural reference:** *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
