
"Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God." (Hebrews 12:2)

The scripture quoted above clearly reveals that Jesus, who is Author and Finisher of our faith, was able to successfully endure the sufferings and shame that He went through, by focusing on the "joy that was set before Him." In other words, by "seeing", through the eyes of the Spirit, the Joy of Salvation that would come to many after His sufferings on the Cross, He was encouraged to go

through all that He went through. He knew that the sufferings were temporary but the Joy of Salvation that would come after was eternal! As Christians, every one of us ought to know the same truth! Beyond every suffering there's joy of salva-

tion or victory! Our focus must be set on the joy of victory which lies ahead rather than the present sufferings that we are going through! It is written, *"For I reckon that the*

sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." (Romans 8:18). In other words, the glory which will come after the sufferings is much greater! So let us choose to focus on what is greater! This is the reason why the Bible encourages us in 2 Corinthians 4:18 not to focus on the temporary things which we can see (with our natural senses) but on the eternal things (the Word of God, which we cannot see with our natural senses, but is there for us to grasp by faith!). As Jesus did, let us focus on the joy that comes after our sufferings, and overcome the world by our faith! (see 1 John 5:4).

Remember That Weeping May Endure For A Night But Joy Comes In The Morning!

"For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning." (Psalm 30:5)

One truth we must al-

ways remember, as Christians, is that every circumstance in this world is subject to change if it is contrary to the Word of God. As Psalm 84:6 says, we may sometimes pass through "the valley of weeping" but we can turn that valley of weeping into a pool of blessings! This is done by trusting in God and focusing our attention on Him rather than the circumstance (see Psalm 84:1-12). As we do so, the night of weeping will soon turn into a dawn of joy! Hallelujah!

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
