A Word In Season

"For the Lord giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding. [7] He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous: he is a buckler to them that walk uprightly." (Proverbs 2:6-7)

Heavenly Wisdom Or Earthly Wisdom: Which One Are You Living By?

"This wisdom descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. [17] But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy." (James 3:15,17)

There is a big difference between earthly wisdom, which is naturally common to the world, and heavenly wisdom, which God expects every Christian to live by. James 3:15,17 quoted above, if taken in context from verses 13-18, clearly shows that earthly and heavenly wisdom are not the same. Also, 1 Corinthians 2:6-7 clearly distinguishes between the wisdom of this world and the wisdom of God, and encourages Christians to live by the wisdom of God. Living by the wisdom of God is the key to pleasing God on the one hand and simultaneously defeating

the devil on the other.

Now, the wisdom of God is developed in us by the Holy Spirit as we study and meditate the Word of God. As it is written, *"And*

that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus." (2 Timothy 3:15). Furthermore, in Matthew 7:24 Jesus said those who hear His Word and do them are those who are wise. It is therefore clear that it is the Word of God that has the ability to impart the Wisdom of God to us! Knowing this truth makes it easy for each one of us to find out, at any time, whether we are living by God's (heavenly) wisdom or man's (earthly) wisdom by simply checking whether our deeds are in agreement with the Word of God or not.

Do You Know That Nothing In This World Is As Valuable As The Wisdom of God?


"For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it." (Proverbs 8:11)

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
