A Word In Season

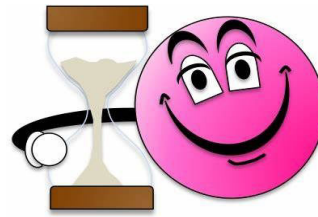

The Word Of God Will Surely Come To Pass!

“And the LORD answered me, and said, Write the vision, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it. ³ For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.” (Habakkuk 2:2-3)

The Word of God will surely come to pass no matter how long it may seem to take to do so! God has clearly revealed this truth to us in several places in the Holy Bible. Therefore, none of us has any reason to doubt the fulfillment of God’s

Promises, as long as we choose to believe and obey whatsoever He says we should do regarding them. In Habakkuk 2:3 quoted above, God told Habakkuk to plainly write down, run with, and wait for the fulfillment of His Word, even though it may take long,

because it will surely come to pass. All Habakkuk needed to do was believe and obey God’s instruction to write down, run with, and wait for His Word. As long as he did

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

Scriptural reference: *“And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man’s wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).*

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *“But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.” (John 4:23-24).*

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
