A Word In Season

"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. [2] Therefore will not we fear, though the earth be removed, and though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea; [3] Though the waters thereof roar and be troubled, though the mountains shake with the swelling thereof. Selah. [4] There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. [5] God is in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, and that right early." (Psalm 46:1-5)

You Ought To Boldly Say That The Lord Is Your Helper!

"So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me." (Hebrews 13:6)

No matter the circumstance, Christians ought to be saying boldly that the Lord is their Helper! This is because they have access to God, the only Source of true help! The arm of flesh will fail but God never fails! (see Jeremiah 17:5-8). This basic understanding is what made the Psalmist to say boldly in Psalm 121:2, "My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth."

Boldness comes from two

main sources:

1. The Word of God, producing full assurance or full persuasion of faith in us. In other words, when we have allowed the word of God to persuade us and set our hearts in total agreement with God, without any shadow of doubt. This comes by diligently

> meditating in the Word of God and choosing to believe it rather than leaning on our human under

standing (see Romans 4:18-21).

2. The Holy Spirit, filling us with Divine Boldness when we pray faith-filledprayer (see Acts 4:23-31).

These two sources are available to every Christian. But diligently fellowshipping in them is required for anyone to access the BOLDNESS that they can supply. This is why the Bible says in Acts 4:13 that when the people saw the **BOLDNESS** of Peter and John they acknowledged them as having been in fellowship with Jesus! Both of them were diligent in the fellowship of the Word and Prayer! (Acts 2:42; 3:1; 6:4).

Choose To Look To God Almighty Alone For Help!

"I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. [2] My help cometh from the Lord, which made heaven and earth." (Psalm 121:1-2)

"I WILL" in the above scripture signifies that a PERSONAL CHOICE is involved. The responsibility to make choices, no matter the circumstance, belongs to every individual person. Therefore it is vitally important that each one of us pay careful attention to the choices we make in order to ensure that we allow God to help us! The key to getting help from God is to have faith in His Word and pray accordingly. (Proverbs 3:5-6; Psalms 37:5; 28:6-7; 115:9-11; Acts 4:24-31).

The Arm Is As You Believe

Let's open once more to Psalm 62:1-12. We read it earlier this morning, and we give God all the glory that it is in line with what the Lord wants to speak to us, what He wants to teach us today, in the name of Jesus. "Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him cometh my salvation.² He only is my rock and my salvation; he is my defence: I shall not be greatly moved. ³ How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall shall ye be, and as a tottering fence. ⁴ They only consult to cast him down from his excellency: they delight in lies: they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah. ⁵ My soul, wait thou only

upon God; for my expectation is from him. ⁶ He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved. 7 In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
