A Word In Season

"For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: [11] So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void. but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." (Isaiah 55:10-11)

What To Do When God's Promises Seem To Be Taking Too Long To Come To Pass

"And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: [12] That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises." (Hebrews 6:11-12)

Whenever God makes a promise, He always has a "due season" in His Mind for its fulfillment. The "due season" may be short or long. Where many of us often run into problems with our walk of faith is when the "due season" is too long in our own estimation of time. So what do we do in such situation to ensure that we don't forfeit the promise of God? Here are some key things to do:

1. Refuse to doubt. Doubt hinders faith and renders it unfruitful. That's why Jesus said to Peter in Matthew 14:31, "... O thou of little faith,



"And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the promise." (Hebrews 6:15)

> wherefore didst thou doubt?" (see Matthew 14:22-33).

2. Keep believing even if the situation gets


worse. That's why Jesus said to Jairus in Mark 5:36, "... Be not afraid, only believe." (see Mark 5:22-24, 35-43).

- 3. Keep praying in faith, trusting that God will surely grant your request even if He takes long (see Luke 18:1-8)
- 4. Choose to wait patiently for God's "due season". Faith requires patience in order to obtain God's promises (see Hebrews 6:12; 10:36).
- Keep praising and thanking God while you are waiting for God's "due season" (see Habakkuk 3:17-19; Romans 4:20-21).

God Will Surely Perform His Promise If You Steadfastly Believe!

"And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord." (Luke 1:45)

God never fails to perform His promise to anyone who steadfastly believes it! The bible says that God "will hasten (i.e. watch over) His Word to perform it." (Jeremiah 1:12). Also, the bible says that God's Word "will not return unto Him void, but it shall accomplish the purpose why He sent it." (Isaiah 55:11). Therefore, all that is required of you is to believe God's Word without doubting, and He will surely perform it in due season! As it is written, *"If thou* canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." (Mark 9:23).

YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
