(Hebrews 4:12)


Scriptural Reflections On The Benefits Of God’s Word

“The law of the Lord is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. [8] The statutes of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes. [11] Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.” (Psalm 19:7-8,11)

The Word of God has tremendous benefits for anyone who chooses to live by it. According to Psalm 19:11, there is great reward in keeping (i.e. doing) the Word. A

good understanding of the benefits or rewards that God’s Word can bring to our lives will inspire our hearts to strongly desire the Word of God above all other things!

Here are some benefits of God’s Word to reflect on:



“The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the simple.” (Psalm 119:130)

1. The Word of God produces FAITH (Romans 10:17) which enables us to please God (Hebrews 11:6), receive His Promises

(Galatians 3:14), and overcome both the Devil and the world (Ephesians 6:16; 1 John 5:4).

2. The Word of God cleanses and sanctifies us unto HOLINESS (John 15:3; John 17:17, Psalm 119:9) which enables us to experience the Glory of God (Hebrews 12:14)
3. The Word of God is God’s MEDICINE for the healing and health of all aspects of our lives (Proverbs 4:20-22; Psalm 107:20)

The Word Of God Ought To Be The Joy And Rejoicing Of Your Heart!

“Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O Lord God of hosts.” (Jeremiah 15:16)

The most important thing that you treasure



YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.

Scriptural reference: *"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."* (3 John 2).

- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.

Scriptural reference: *"And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God."* (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).

- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.

Scriptural reference: *"But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth."* (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
