# Experiencing God's Miracles Requires Your Hearing Of Faith!

"He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?" (Galatians 3:5)

Experiencing the miracle-working power of God requires your hearing of faith. This is simply because, as the Bible says, "Without faith it is impossible to please God." (Hebrews 11:6). Whenever you allow the Word of God that you hear to produce faith in your heart, you are positioning yourself to experience the miracle-working power of God! That was exactly what the woman

with the issue of blood did in order to experience the miracle-working power of God in her life (see Mark 5:25-34). The Bible says, "<u>When she had heard of</u> <u>Jesus</u>, came in the press behind, and touched his garment. <sup>8</sup> For she said, If I may touch but his

clothes, I shall be whole." (Mark 5:27-28). In other words, she allowed what she had heard about Jesus to produce faith in her. Even though her case had looked hopeless for the

past 12 years, she released her faith in what she had heard about Jesus, and said, "If I may touch but his clothes, I shall be whole," What a clear demonstration of the hearing of faith! No wonder Jesus said in verse 34, "Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole;" because it was her faith that enabled the miracle-working power of God to work for her! Similarly, in Luke 5:17 the Bible says that "the power of God was present to heal" but it only worked a miracle when the paralysed man and his friends came with faith. Verse 20 says, "And when he saw their faith .... " This clearly shows that faith is required in order to experience God's miracleworking power!

## If You Choose To Believe God's Word, All Things Are Possible To You!

"Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." (Mark 9:23)

Most Christians have no problem believing that, *"With God all things are*  possible." Where problem usually sets in is when it comes to personalising it and saying, as it is written, "If I can believe, all things are possible to me!" Yet, it is the personalisation of this truth that releases genuine faith which activates the power of God to turn naturally impossible situations to supernaturally possible ones according to the Word of God. It is not enough to just believe that God can generally do something, you need to believe also that He can do it for you! #### YESHUA CHRISTIAN CHURCH VISION STATEMENT

Yeshua Christian Church is a purpose driven Church born by the will of God for the glorification of Jesus Christ and the blessing of mankind. It is the Church arm of Yeshua Trust – a Christian charity registered in the U.K. (Registered charity No. 1051006).

In addition to the GENERAL VISION for the Church of Jesus Christ which is clearly stated in Matthew 28:18-20 and Mark 16:15-18, Yeshua Christian Church has been commissioned by God to fulfil the following specific vision:

- Build a people who are PERSONALLY fulfilled in Jesus Christ i.e. a people who are whole in Christ. This involves wholeness in their spirit, soul and body.
- Scriptural reference: "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth." (3 John 2).
- Chart a path to personal fulfilment in Christ via the teaching of the uncompromised Word of God and the impartation of the Holy Spirit so that the people may understand not just the Word of God but also the Way of the Holy Spirit.
- Scriptural reference: "And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of Power; that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God." (1 Corinthians 2:4-5).
- Arrive at the ultimate end where such people, having been built up and personally fulfilled in Christ, may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS who worship God in Spirit and in Truth.
- Scriptural reference: "But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in Truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth." (John 4:23-24).

In a nutshell, therefore, the vision of Yeshua Christian Church is to build a people who are PERSONALLY FULFILLED in Christ Jesus via the Word and the Spirit to the ultimate end that they may become TRUE WORSHIPPERS of God.
